1.	Read Romans 8:37-39 and John 15:1-11. What do we learn about God's love regarding his commitment to us and our responsibility to him? How then should we understand Jude's command that we keep ourselves in the love of God?
2.	Read <b>Revelation 2:18-25</b> . What are some of the parallels we see between this church and those to whom Jude was writing? The only command given to the genuine believers in this church is in verse 25. How does this parallel Jude's instructions in <b>Jude 20-21</b> ?

3. Read **2 Timothy 2:24-26**. How does this passage instruct us to engage with those who oppose the gospel (false teachers and their disciples)? What should be our motivation in our conversations with them?

4. In Jude 23 we are instructed to hate the garment stained by the flesh. What does this mean for our evangelism efforts? What are some principles of discernment that we should employ to safeguard ourselves from the stained garments of those we wish to see saved?
